Funeral Arrangements

As Funeral Directors, we will make all the funeral arrangements, as requested. We will guide you through all the options available so as to provide a completely individual service for you requirements. All religious services are catered for, as are non-religious ceremonies.

We offer a completely confidential service at all times.

If the death occurs in hospital

Contact us and inform us of the death. All arrangements can then be made for you at your convenience.

If the death occurs at home

Inform the doctor immediately. The doctor can then attend the place of death and certify the death.

We can then attend (at any time day or night) and bring the deceased into our care.

The Registrar

The law requires that every death should be registered within a certain time and stipulates the persons responsible for doing this.

We will provide you with all the necessary information, times and offices that are available in the area concerned.

The Coroner

If the death is sudden or unexpected the doctor must inform the police. They in turn report the death to the Coroner, who may request a postmortem. You should not be alarmed by this, in most cases it is only a formality.

We will liaise with the Coroner and advise you as necessary.

Newspaper Notices

Announcements can be placed in any local or national newspaper. We can advise on the wording and place the notice on your behalf.

Flowers

All forms of floral tribute can be ordered by us or by you visiting the florist personally.

Printing

Service Sheets, Attendance Cards, Thanks Cards and all types of personalised stationery are available on request.

Catering

We can help you arrange this in your own home or at a venue of your choice.

Donations to Charity

Donations to requested charities may be sent directly to us to administer. When we receive donations we list the senders' names and forward you a copy of this list showing the total amount donated. We then send the donation to the nominated Charities.

Memorials

As well as being Funeral Directors we are also Monumental Masons, having our own workshop. We are able to give estimates for any type of memorial work.

Funerals out of the area

We can arrange Burials and Cremations in any part of the United Kingdom.

Cremated Remains (Ashes) may also be forwarded to most destinations for final laying to rest or dispersal.

Repatriation

We offer a worldwide repatriation service.

Chapel of Rest
